

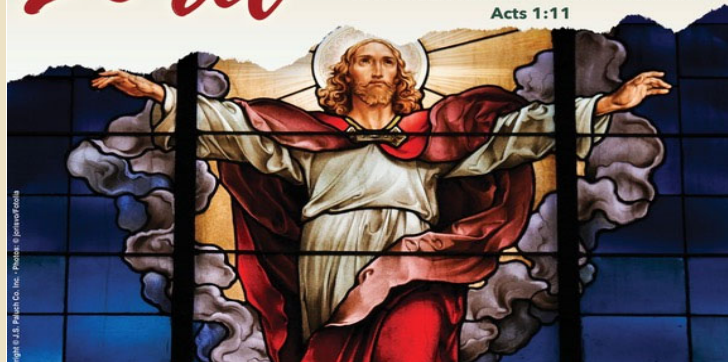

We continue to inch closer to our \$5 million goal for the Learning to Walk with God Capital Campaign, however we are not there yet and not everyone has made their pledge. The end of the solicitation phase of the campaign will be complete on June 10th and 11th. That weekend at all the Masses any families who have not yet contributed to the campaign will have the opportunity to do so via pledge cards that will be in the pews.

This is an important initiative in the life of our parish. With the number of families we expect to add to the parish in the coming years, our parish needs more space. The building project we have put forth addresses a number of issues:

Faith formation for our children— The new building will be a space for our teens and young children to learn about God and grow in their faith.

Faith formation for adults – The Marron Center will be reconfigured to accommodate our adult faith formation and other ministries.

Cry Rooms – Improved cry rooms and changing rooms in the sanctuary will help our young moms and dads to worship.

Parking and traffic flow -- We will be adding about 100 spaces to the parking lot and making improvements to the traffic flow making it easier to get on and off the church grounds after Mass.

As you see, parishioners of all ages truly will benefit from this campaign, and we hope that everyone will find it in their hearts to make a gift – whatever the size – to support the ongoing ministries of our Church.
