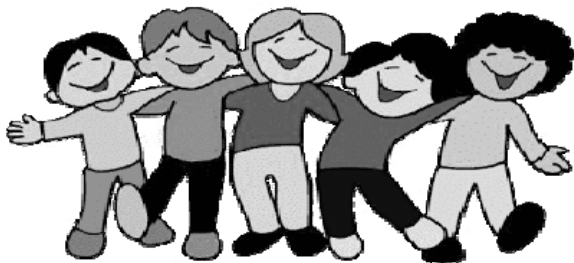
ANNUAL SEAS FLEA MARKET
