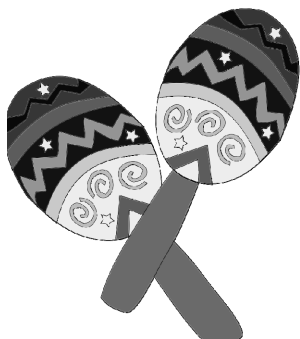

Office will Close at Noon

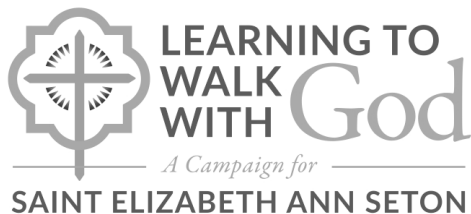
Our parish office will be closing at Noon on Friday April 28.
