### WHAT ARE HABITAT FOR HUMANITY'S FINANCIAL RESOURCES?

Habitat for Humanity depends entirely on the generosity of individuals, churches, corporations and civic groups to raise funds and help build Habitat Houses. Habitat by-laws prohibit using government funds, except for donations of land and infrastructure. Since SEAS parish is hoping to be a co-sponsor of a Habitat House with two other Catholic churches, our share will be \$22,000. All donations of money and materials are tax deductible.

In 1994 Habitat purchased a warehouse at 311 Probandt St. here in San Antonio to house its Habitat Home Center (formerly the ReStore). The purpose of the Habitat Home Center is to raise funds by recycling and selling donated new and used building materials to the public at very affordable prices. The funds generated by the Home Center pay for all the administrative costs of the San Antonio Habitat office personnel. Thus, **EVERY** dollar donated for a Habitat House is used for construction costs!
