Dear Parents,

Attached are the forms and guidelines for obtaining the Sacrament of Baptism for Infants (newborns—age 6) at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church.

We ask you to read them carefully and provide the parish office with all the required information necessary as you prepare for the baptism of your child. All information needed is in conformity with the Guidelines for Infant Baptism for the Archdiocese of San Antonio.

Baptism is no mere social convention, but the Sacrament in which Christ Himself purifies, justifies and sanctifies (cf. 1 Peter 1:23) your child for eternal life. We rejoice with you in the birth of your child and look forward to welcoming him/her into the family of God and the communion of the Holy Catholic Church.

The Sacrament of Baptism is currently celebrated the first and third Saturday of each month at 11:00 am. Your child's baptism may be scheduled once all requirements are completed.

Infant Baptism Policy at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church

The Sacrament of Baptism is currently celebrated the first and third Saturday of each month at 11:00 am.

For	Parents	

Attend a Baptism Preparation Class, either at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (classes are held the second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm in the
church) or another parish (if you have taken a baptism class within the past three years, you do not need to take another class).
Complete Infant Baptism Request Form and return it to the Parish Office, along with the following:

- Copy of your child's State-registered Birth Certificate
- Certificates of attendance at a Baptism Preparation class within the past three years, for parents and Godparents
- If you are not a parishioner of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, please request a letter from your parish pastor granting permission for your child to be baptized at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton.

For Godparents:

 Inform Godparents of their requirements to attend a Baptism Preparation Class (again, if they have taken one of these classes within the page
three years, this will not be necessary but we must have proof of attendance).
 Have each Godparent fill out and sign the Godparents Certificate (page 4 of this packet).
Ask each Godparent to request a Letter of Verification of Full Communion with the Catholic Church from their parish. The letter must be
signed by the pastor and stamped with the parish seal.

Please note, per the Archdiocese of San Antonio, "A lapsed Catholic may not serve as a Christian witness."

For a person to stand as a Godparent or Sponsor, the following requirements must be met: (Can. 874.1)

- The godparents are to be chosen by the parents or guardians.
- They are to be at least sixteen (16) years of age.
- They must be Catholics fully initiated in the Catholic Church having received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation.
- They should be leading their life in harmony with the faith; i.e., practicing Catholics (attending Mass), if married, in a valid Catholic Marriage, etc.
- They may not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized.
- You may choose one or two godparents. If you choose two, one must be male and the other female.
- The godparents must have the qualifications for and intention of carrying out this duty.
- Each Godparent must provide proof of Confirmation and Catholic marriage (if married).
- If not registered in this parish, they must provide a letter, with the parish seal, from their parish which they attend stating they are eligible and have permission to serve as Godparents.
- Godparents are required to attend baptismal preparation classes at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton or another Catholic Church. If they have attended a class in the past three years, they do not need to retake the class, but must provide proof of attendance.
- Non-Catholic Witness (Can. 874.2) A <u>baptized</u> person belonging to a non-Catholic ecclesial (church) community may be admitted as a witness to baptism but only along with a Catholic Godparent. This person is not formally called a Godparent, but will be referred to as a Christian Witness.
